Technical Rider - 'Ireland and Québec in Music and Film' (2022)

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CONCERT: *Trilangue*:

- 1. Inhouse (or on-stage) speakers
- 2. 10-channel mixing board
- 3. two stage monitors
- 4. (4) omni directional vocal mics and boom stands
- 5. (2) unidirectional mics (for the concertina) with short boom or straight stands
- 6. (2) jack input cables for the violins
- 7. a direct input for the piano.
- 8. An sound technician experienced with traditional instruments
- 9. Sound check 3 hours prior to the performance
- 10. Piano / keyboard:

A full length (88 key/weighted) electronic piano keyboard with pedal(s) and a stand.

Alternatively, an upright/straight-back acoustic piano – in perfect tune (A440 standard pitch)

Tuning checked by a professional tuner prior to the arrival of the ensemble.

11. CD sales table with (if possible) an assistant to help with sales during the intermission.

FILM SCREENING: Lost Children of the Carricks (55 minutes)

- 1. Quality "broadband" Internet signal in cinema projection room
- 2. The film will be projected from the director's MacBook Air laptop from a password protected website.
- 3. HDMI adapter cables will be provided by the director (personal). The cinema should have its own projector interface cable to receive this Mac-based system.
- 4. Screen check: 3 hours prior to the performance to test for image and sound quality.
- 5. Film should continue to run through the final credits and musical conclusion.
- 6. Copyright: The film will not be uploaded onto an autonomous house system. Absolutely no copy of this film may be downloaded, borrowed, sampled or reproduced without written permission of the director.
